

District 13 Regional MWR Westport Lighthouse RV & Tent Campground

Location:

The Coast Guard's Westport RV and Tent campground is located in Grays Harbor County, Westport, WA. The address is 1000 W. Ocean Ave, Westport, WA 98595. Westport is located 20 miles south of Aberdeen, WA, 130 miles southwest of Seattle, 164 miles north of Portland, OR, and 86 miles directly north of Astoria, OR.

Season of Operation: 1 May to 31 October.

Description:

Located at Grays Harbor Lighthouse; a well maintained campground that's minutes walking distance to the coast/beach and near community attractions.

Facilities:

There are 5 RV and 7 tent sites. RV sites have water and electric hook-ups, standing barbecue grills, fire-pits and picnic tables. Tent sites have standing barbecue grills, fire-pits and picnic tables. Bathrooms are available within the campground with toilets, sinks, and showers.

Activities:

There are an array of activities to do in Westport - swimming, fishing, hiking, charter boat fishing, boating, shopping, and bicycle touring.

Recreation Equipment Available:

None.

General Information:

There are no RV sanitary hookups. There is a central dump station available. Open fires are permitted only in the fire-pits and barbecue grills. Campers must bring their own firewood. Camp fires are to be kept small for cooking and enjoyable camping. Cutting down trees or breaking off branches for firewood is strictly prohibited. Pets are allowed, but must be kept on a leash. Owners must clean up after pets. Horses are not allowed on the campground. The number of vehicles is limited to one car/camper, or one vehicle with trailer per camp site. Other vehicles are to be parked just outside the campground in the designated parking slots. Authorized patrons must check-in with the Officer of the Day (OOD) at USCG Station Grays Harbor to read, date and sign the Patron Use Agreement outlining the policies governing the campground and to sign a hand-receipt for a set of two keys which will open the male and female restroom doors (same key both doors) and a lock on the front gate to gain vehicle access to the campground. The OOD will ascertain the validity of the customer's reservation. Upon departure, the keys **must** be returned to the OOD.

Reservations:

Eligibility is in accordance with Chapter 3 of the MWR Manual. Requests for reservations will be directed to the Base Seattle MWR Office via telephone (571-607-5460 / 206-815-2645) or in person. Eligible MWR patrons may make reservations for the May-October camping season starting mid-January. Requests should arrive at least two weeks prior to the requested check-in date and requests will be processed in the order received.

Requests may be made for a specific campsite(s), however the Base Seattle MWR Office will make all final campsite(s) assignments. Payment will be cash, check or money order if made in person at the MWR Office; if mailing payment, check/money order only, to the following address:

Check-In / Check-out:

As mentioned above, check-in and check-out is with the OOD at the USCG Station Grays Harbor, Westport, WA.

Check-in Time: 11:00 AM – 10:00 PM.

Check-out Time: Before 11:00 AM.

Driving Instructions:

The Westport RV and tent campground is located on the same property as the Grays Harbor Westport Lighthouse. From Seattle: Take I-5 southbound towards Portland. Take the US-101 North exit (Exit 104) towards Aberdeen/Port Angeles. Merge onto US-101 N. Take WA-8 W towards Montesano/Aberdeen. WA-8 W becomes US-12 W. US-12 W becomes US 101 N. Upon arrival in Aberdeen, follow the directional signs to US-105 S. Upon arrival in Westport, take a right on South Montesano Street. Continue on South Montesano Street, go through the stop sign, and follow the road as it bends to the left. Turn right at the next intersection, E. Wilson Ave. USCG Station Grays Harbor will be on your right. Call the telephone number on the front gate's intercom box and inform the watchstander who you are and you're there to check-in to the campground. To travel to the campground, you'll exit the base and turn left and keep straight and at the third Stop sign you'll make a right on W Ocean Ave and travel approximately ¼ mile, the entrance to the Lighthouse and campground will be on your right.
